

New Awards

Last term we we launched our very first Holy Trinity Award (our own Duke of Edinburgh style award). Children had to evidence a series of four exciting challenges linked to the theme of being voices for change and supporting the community. Any child can work towards these goals.

Children source four pieces of evidence and submit their evidence to Mrs Rowe and a governor to win a special badge.

We are keen to ensure our school vision and values continue beyond the school gates and into the local community.

So far we have seen a lot of interest and children are talking about them. I looking forward to seeing the documents to talk through what they have done. We look forward to handing out the first badge!

STEM SCIENCE PROJECT

We are very excited to be part of the 2024 MARS Balloon project that is run by STEM Ambassadors from Thales Alenia Space. The project aims to test anything that humans or robots could be doing on Mars in the future. Holy Trinity will be sending up to 3 capsules, along with 150 others, on a high altitude balloon 30km up into the Earth's atmosphere, a place where the conditions of air pressure, temperature and radiation are similar to those on the surface of Mars. This project will allow students to test how various items would respond to the Martian environment, many of which have never been tried before, to potentially make new scientific and engineering discoveries. The children are working together to determine what items they wish to send in their capsules and will receive their capsules back after the flight to determine the impact of the journey. We are sure this will be a very interesting and insightful experiment for the children and are looking forward to seeing the results!
