For environmental and cost reasons we are launching a drive to reduce, reuse and recycle at Holy Trinity. On Tuesday we had a presentation in assembly from the recycling team at Braintree District Council. After half term we will be reinforcing separate recycling and refuse bins in classrooms with new signage, and the staff room and kitchen will be getting food recycling bins. We will also be asking the children who have packed lunches to take their rubbish home, both so you can see what your child is eating, and to save the school money - we are charged per bag for rubbish collection. Don't forget we also have a battery recycling bin outside the school office too so please keep bringing them in when they are no longer any use.

WOW ASSEMBLY

After the enforced break due to COVID, we would like to invite parents / carers in for our Friday Celebration Worship from Friday 4th November at 2.30pm. Due to space constraints we will prioritise the families of children who are receiving a certificate - we will let children know they are WOW on Thursday afternoon.

CLASS REWARDS

Although we strive for intrinsic motivation, rewards are still very important to us at Holy Trinity. We have kept most systems from last year such as colour team points, WOW certificates and raffle tickets. The only difference to our system is a 50-point class reward. Children work towards 50 points and then have a class treat as voted for by their class and agreed by the class teacher. They love the opportunity to have den building/ film afternoons / baking etc. We feel this system is as effective as Golden Time in spurring on good behaviour. It also allows more curriculum time for children so that they will be able to achieve the expected standards by the end of the year. It is very unusual to hear of Golden Time in primary schools in recent times.

At school we use the browser extension 'uBlock Origin' to block adverts - it is available for most browsers. On mobile devices the Opera & Brave browsers have built-in ad-blockers where Chrome does not. For YouTube we use the 'AdBlock for YouTube' extension. Please check all online resources carefully for suitability before your children use them. We recommend the NSPCC website www.net-aware.org.uk for advice on specific apps and websites, and there are other useful e-safety links on our website www.holytrinityhalstead.com/esafety
