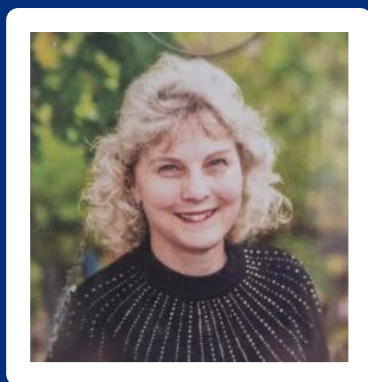
Mrs Cook loves the colour pink and she is amazing at reading stories because she does all the funny voices!

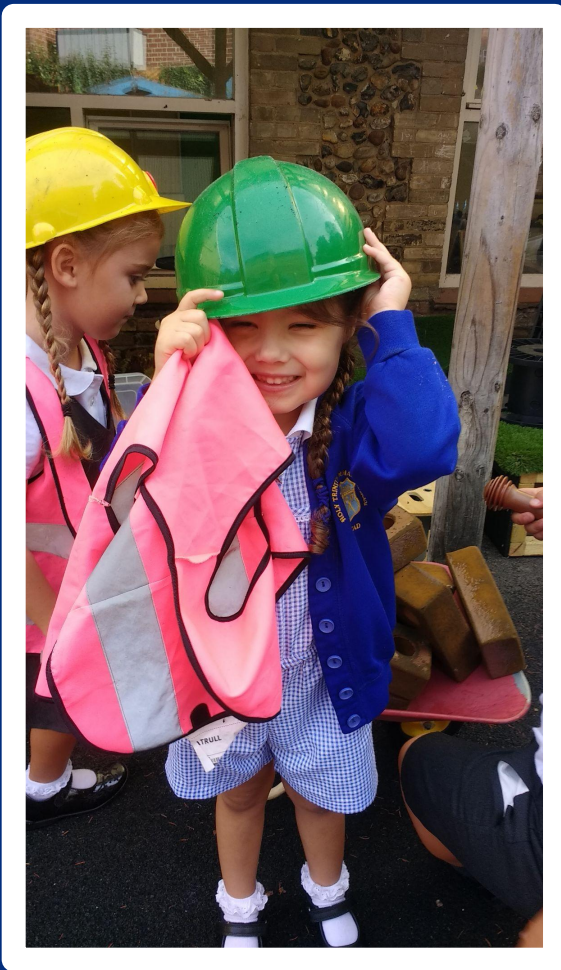
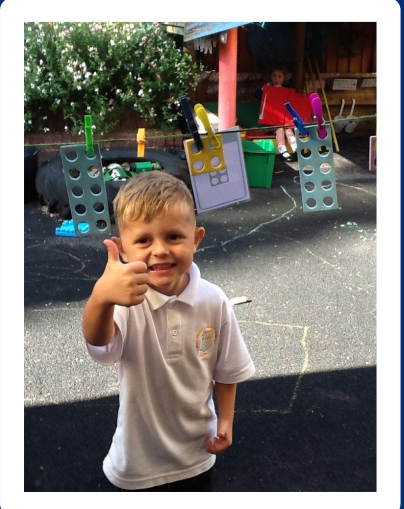

We have our own outside area to learn and play in.



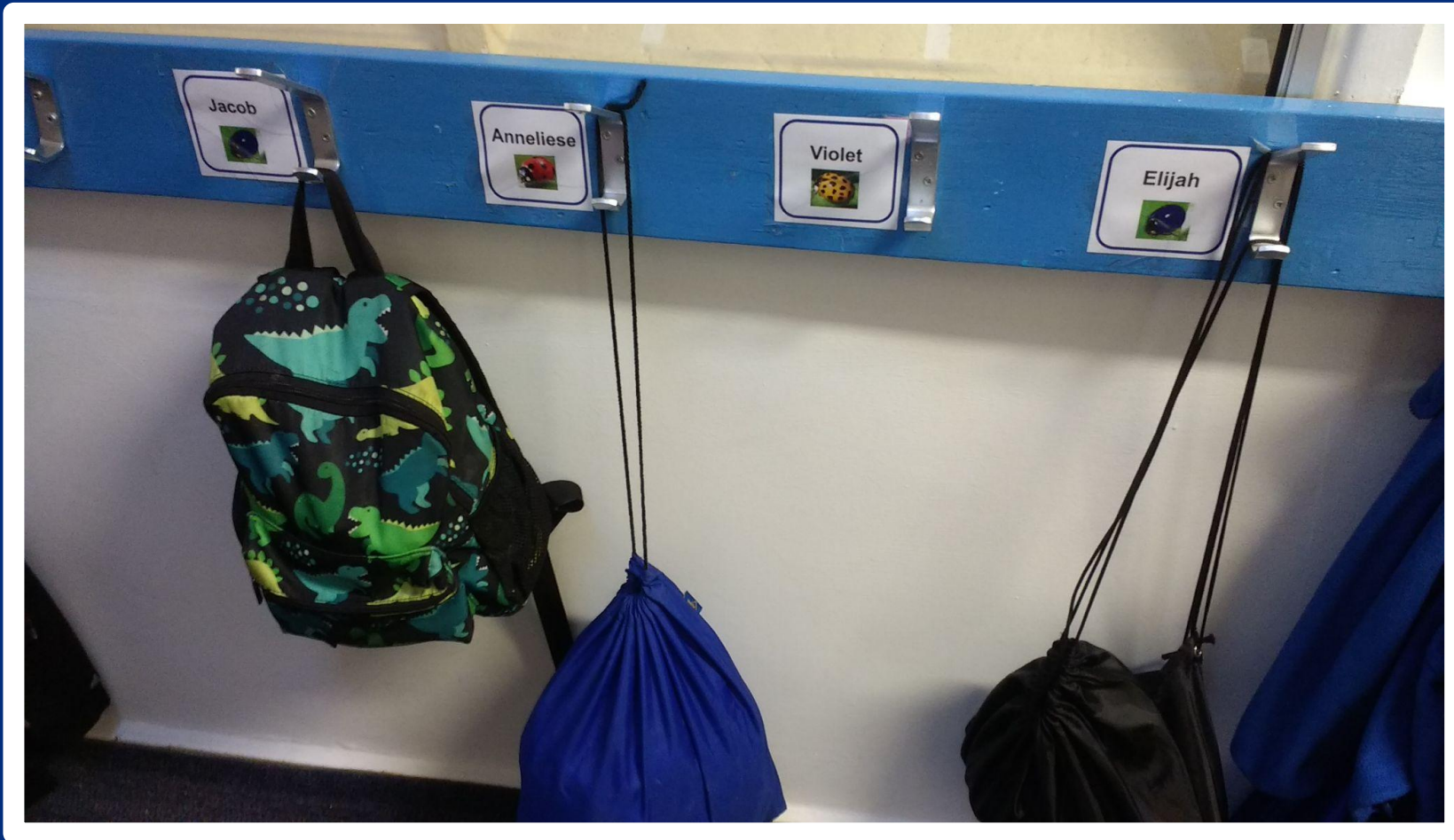
# Uniform

You will have a PE kit to keep on your peg.



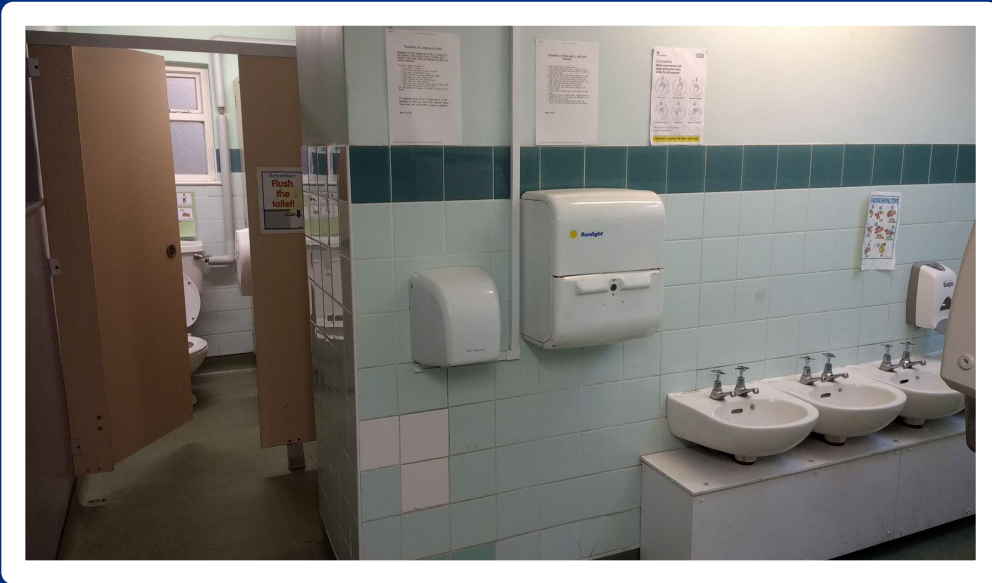
# Pegs

The toilets are right next to our classroom. Remember you can go anytime you need to, if you need help just have to ask and we will be there.

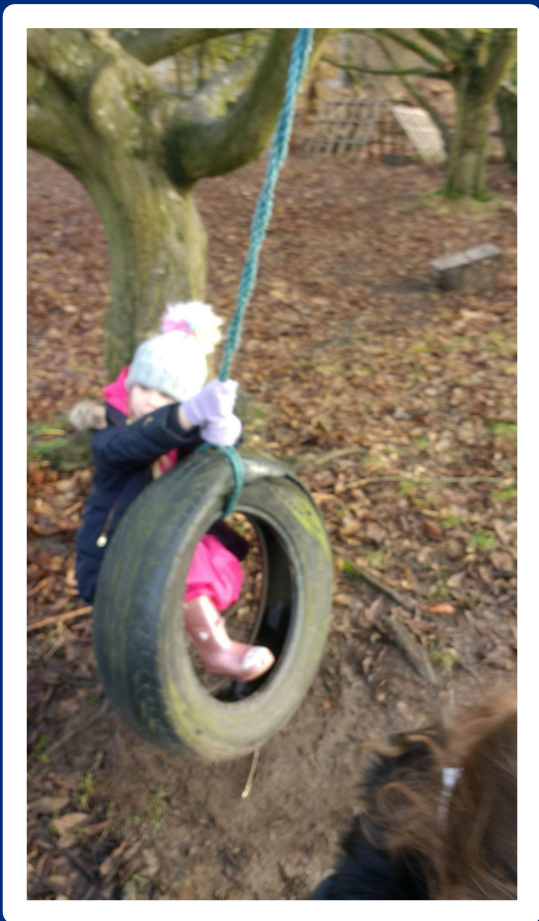


# Library

# Learning Powers

All the skills we need at school
