Over the last couple of weeks we have ensured that the theme of kindness, alongside the message of anti-bullying, has been a focus for the school day. Children at Holy Trinity really do look out for each other and take on the key messages of the week. Only a day ago, I was impressed to see a group of Year 5 children who had written, through their own free will, a poem on equality and friendship during their lunch break. How blessed we are to have such thoughtful children in our school!

The winter bugs are starting to hit so many of us and I am aware that sometimes making decisions on whether to send your child in is a difficult one. However, improving attendance is both a school and a national priority. Last week we introduced an attendance competition between classes (with children with high medical needs discounted). I am hoping that with a collaborative effort we can reach 96% or more in classes, in line with national expectations. Persistent late arrivals and poor overall attendance could result in formal procedures.

WrapAround Care

We have listened to the wishes of the parents / carers in our community and as a result have embarked on plans to have Little Oaks run wraparound care before and after school, from September 2023 at the very latest. More details will follow in due course.

WORLD CUP 2022 - CREATE A COUNTRY POSTER!


The school council are holding a competition, open to all pupils, to create an information poster about one of the 32 countries taking part in this year's World Cup.
